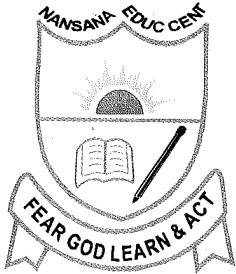

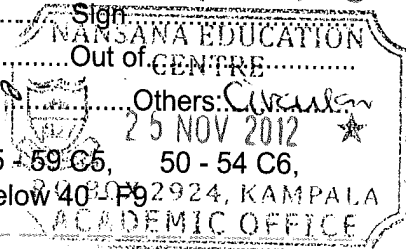

## END OF ACADEMIC YEAR 2012 REPORT/COMMUNICATION TO THE PARENTS/GUARDIANS.

Warm greetings and salutation come to you dear parents and guardians in the loving name of our Saviour Jesus Christ. We thank the Provider for sailing us through the academic year 2012 successfully. We have this 25<sup>th</sup> November, 2012 come to the end of the academic year 2012, these circulars and report cards have been issued to the parents and guardians after the meeting.

### REPORT

#### **1. ACADEMICS:**

- a) **Staff News:** The staff has remained committed and creative, motivating students to work harder for better grades. We have had a strong boost in our staffing, engaging more experienced examiners to ensure academic excellence for our learners.
- b) **Reference Reading Materials:** At least more reading and reference materials have been acquired and have really boosted our book bank encouraging the learners and the school community to make better reference of them. There has been an upward shift in the way students make use of the reading materials which is really impressive.
- c) **Laboratory:** More relevant required equipment and reagents have regularly been purchased and the science practicals for classes S.3, 4, 5 and 6 have run smoothly. It should be remembered that for the past years, our science department has been doing well to an extent that even at entry into university after S.6, we have had the best grades from science. For the in-take 2012/2013, we had many candidates on government sponsorship. Please find more records in the office to be up to date.
- d) **Tests and Exams:** We have conducted enough seminars, discussions and enough field study tours this year, more weekend packages, assessment tests and exams for all classes in order to groom students for better grades. To our judgments, we have left "no bomb unexploded". More visiting facilitators more so for classes 4 & 6 in most subjects to prepare the candidates more have been engaged to add their voice and share their experiences in a bid to instill confidence in the learners. We hope for better grades.

#### **2. DISCIPLINE:**

The discipline in the school community continues to attract everyone. The students' discipline continues to be commendable and this is really attributed to the staff who have continued to be role models, depicting a good example, coupled to the God fearing spirit which we have inculcated in our learners, these factors have helped to lift and maintain the morals and discipline. However like in any society, there have been some "black sheep", and these cases have always been counseled, prayed for, punished and the extreme cases ex-communicated for the betterment of the NEC community. Plans are under way to lift sports and games more with more regular professional training and practice.
- b) **The music and drama is not neglected.** There have come up many choirs and drama groups. These have had their talents identified and developed, have served near and far with both gospel music and secular music, which is more educative and entertaining.
- c) **Other clubs have been equally active and useful.** The writers' club as one of the most useful and active in the school community, the Nkobazambogo, the debating club, pathfinder club and others. Sincerely, our learners have been trained to be all round students and wholistic.

#### 4. ACHIEVEMENTS

- As stated earlier, acquisition of enough land for expansion, the project will be embarked on next year. We call for your support, a productive school garden, a school truck, better grades which put us on front page in the UCE and UACE national ranking, with many first grades and university government sponsored students for the past five years, among the most disciplined schools in the country. 
#### 9. APPRECIATION:
