Goes to those who have had achievement in various sectors



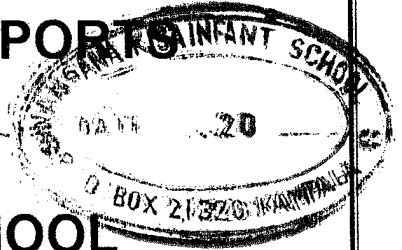

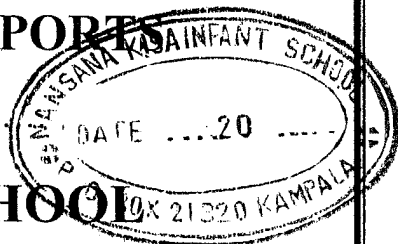
